WHEREAS, the bids of **AZURRO HOTELS AND LEISURE, INC.** and **FONTANA DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION** were above the ABC. Moreover, both did not comply with the submission of Certification of PhilGEPS registration, therefore, both were not responsive;

WHEREAS, the **SAVANNAH RESORT HOTEL** was not responsive since it did not comply with the PCAF specifications such as the preferred location and the allowed hours of use of the conference room;

WHEREAS, the lone responsive bidder, the **NEW WELL BEING SPA CITY CORPORATION (LOHAS HOTEL)** complied with the PCAF specifications, submitted Certificate of PhilGEPS registration, and was within the ABC, hence, was declared as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid;




