RECOMMENDING TO THE HEAD OF THE PROCURING ENTITY (HOPE) THE FAILURE OF PUBLIC BIDDING FOR THE "SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MOTOR VEHICLES," THE REVISION OF THE SPECIFICATIONS AND REBIDDING

WHEREAS, it is a paramount commitment of the Government of the Philippines (GOP) to promote good governance and to adhere to the principles of transparency, accountability, equity, efficiency, and economy in its procurement process in accordance with RA 9184, otherwise known as "Government Procurement Reform Act.";

WHEREAS, an Invitation to Bid No. 2018-04 for Supply and Delivery of Motor Vehicles with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 8,500,000.00) was posted in the PhilGEPS along with its Bidding Documents last November 21, 2018;

WHEREAS, only one (1) supplier namely Toyota Quezon Avenue, Inc. submitted a bid and preliminary evaluation of the 1st envelope containing the Eligibility and Technical Documents indicated that the bidder has passed the eligibility requirements, thus the second envelope containing the Financial Documents was opened and the BAC has endorsed the submitted documents to the Technical Working Group (TWG) for further evaluation.

WHEREAS, the results of the TWG Evaluation were as follows:

Other Attachments ; Secretary's Certificate			On the Secretary's Certificate submitted by Toyota Quezon Avenue, Inc., it was stated that Ms. Rosalyn Landicho is the duly authorized & designated representative to participate in the bidding of Supply and Delivery of Motor Vehicles (ITB No. 2018-04) for PCAF during the Board of Directors Meeting of Toyota Corporation conducted on June 18, 2018 which is five (5) months prior to the posting of the said requirements to PhilGEPS on November 21, 2018.

WHEREAS, the BAC upon careful deliberation and examination of the documents had agreed with the evaluation of the TWG that the bid of Toyota Quezon Avenue did not comply with the technical specifications as stated in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, having established that the bidder was Non-responsive to the bid requirements of PCAF, the BAC hereby declare a failure of bidding;

WHEREAS, the BAC has determined that some specifications present only for an automatic transmission pick-up truck was inadvertently included in the procurement of a manual transmission unit, thereby causing non-compliance in the evaluation of the technical specifications;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as it is hereby resolved, that the BAC recommends to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) a failure of bidding for the Supply and Delivery of Motor Vehicles and the revision of the specifications suited to the vehicle to be procured and the conduct of re-bidding as soon as possible.


