**RECOMMENDING TO THE HEAD OF THE PROCURING ENTITY (HOPE) THE APPROVAL OF THE NOTICE OF AWARD TO D'TRIUMPH CLEANERS AND ALLIED SERVICES, INC. FOR HAVING SUBMITTED THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID RELATIVE TO PCAF'S PROCUREMENT OF ONE YEAR JANITORIAL SERVICES FOR 2019**

**WHEREAS**, the PCAF had issued an Invitation to Bid No. 2018-03 for the Procurement of One (1) Year Janitorial Services to Maintain Cleanliness and Sanitation of PCAF Offices and its Premises for 2019.

**WHEREAS**, three (3) prospective bidders namely D'Triumph Cleaners and Allied Services, Inc., Dearjohn Services, Inc. and The Perfect Cleaners Sales and Services responded to the invitation and submitted their respective bid documents;

**WHEREAS** all of the three (3) bidders upon careful evaluation by the BAC-TWG has passed the eligibility, technical and financial requirements screening and for fair evaluation, the bids of D'Triumph Cleaners and Allied Services, Inc. and The Perfect Cleaners Sales and Services were recalculated resulting to a three-way tie together with Dearjohn Services, Inc., for the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) in the amount of One Million Eight Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Six Hundred Ninety One Pesos and Fifty Two Centavos (Php 1,885,691.52);

**WHEREAS**, having similar bids the three suppliers were required to submit their respective latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS) as a post qualification requirement;

**WHEREAS**, all the bidders have submitted the said document as required on time and all are in order, thus everything being equal, the BAC-TWG as per Bidding Documents' ITB Clause 29.3 under Post Qualification which states that *"the determination shall be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted... as well as other information as the Procuring Entity deems necessary and appropriate...."* Thus the BAC-TWG obtained information of the three bidders' performance in terms of client satisfaction as evaluated by their former clients to determine which of the three had the highest satisfactory rating and the basis as to whom to award the contract;

**WHEREAS**, the results as gathered by the BAC-TWG were as follows (see attached for details)

- D'Triumph Cleaners and Allied Services, Inc. : Very Satisfactory Performance;  
No complaints from previous contract.

- Dea John Services, Inc. : Satisfactory Performance;  
No complaints from previous contract
- The Perfect Cleaners Sales and Services : Performance Needs to Improve;  
Has complaints from previous contract.

**WHEREAS**, the BAC decided to award the contract to D'Triumph Cleaners and Allied Services, Inc. for having a very satisfactory rating and passed the criteria for post evaluation, had complied and was responsive to the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents and thus be declared as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid:

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as it is hereby resolved, that the BAC recommends to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) to award to **D'Triumph Cleaners and Allied Services, Inc.** PCAF's procurement of janitorial services for 2019 in the amount of **One Million Eight Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Nine Pesos and Sixty Centavos (PhP 1,885,689.60)** for having offered the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid.


